IMPORTANT 2010 SUMMER SERIES UPDATES

The Open and Non-Pro classes will offer \$50 in added money (in addition to the normal jackpot portion) at each Summer Series show for the 2010 show season.

The Two-Handed and Green horse classes have been combined into an Open Ranch Horse class for 2010.

The 1000 Novice Non-Pro class has been eliminated for 2010. The 1000 Novice Horse class has been replaced by the 1500 Novice Horse class

Please contact one of your officers or board members if you have questions regarding these changes.

To qualify for 2010 year-end awards you must show in one half of the summer series shows (formerly qualification required participation in ½ + 1 of the total summer series shows)

The Class order will flip for each show – meaning that the order below will be how the classes run at Summer Series #1 and they will go the opposite way (Ranch Horse first, Open last) at Summer Series #2; then they will go back to the order listed below for Summer Series #3, etc.

SUMMER SERIES FOOD

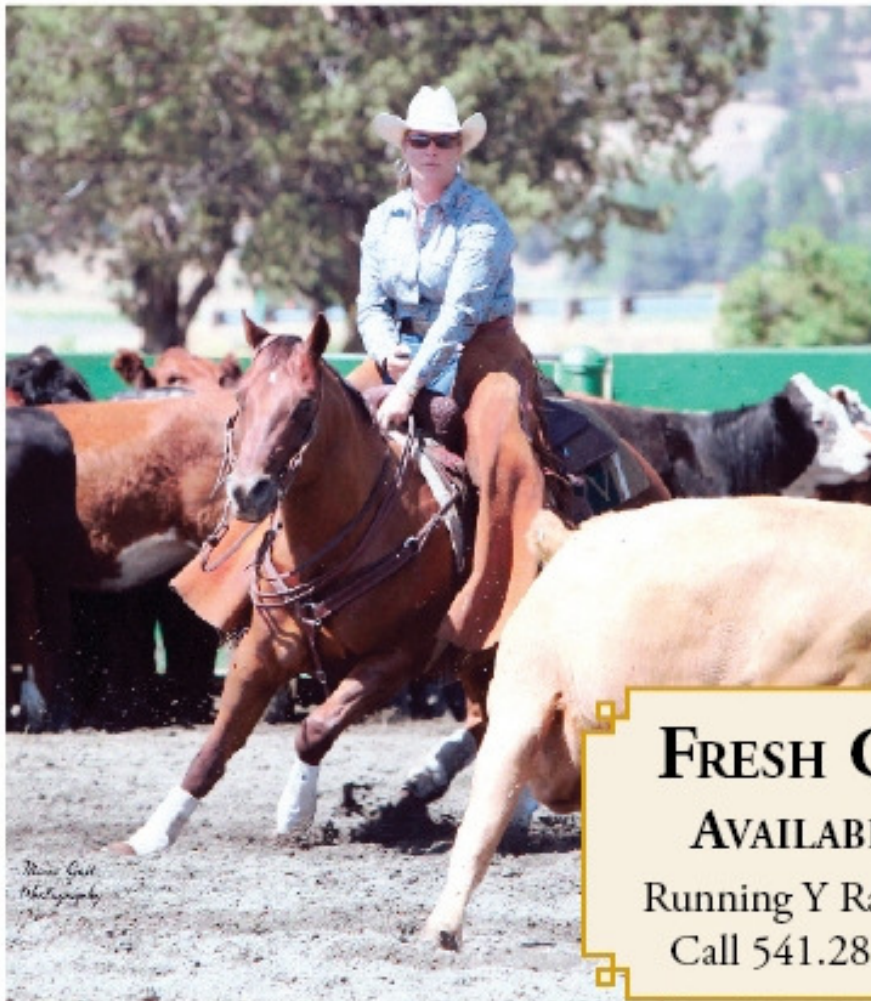


